Discussion 3. Are there particular truths in scripture that you turn to often these days? How do those truths help you better understand or cope with the realities of our current culture?
American Christians should pray that we might one day learn what our brothers and sisters around the world have already learned: to "rejoice in being as a drink offering". Shouldn't we?
Discussion 4. Why do you think we (The Gathering) focus every week on persecuted Christians around the world? What impact, if any, does that focus have on your day-to-day mindset throughout the week? Do you believe we are hindered in our spiritual growth unless or until we experience persecution for our faith? Why or why not?
Discussion 5. How does this lesson cause you to pray? How does it prepare

your heart for worship?
