## Abundant Life

John 10:7-10

*The spiritually meaningful relationship with God for which we were created can only be achieved through Jesus. Following Him leads to the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ life for which we were intended.*

**Discussion 1. What kinds of things come to mind for you when you think of a “full and satisfying” life? Do you think those things that come to your mind will change, the longer you walk with Jesus? Why or why not?**

**Discussion 2. How do you know if you have a scarcity mindset versus an abundance mindset? How can you test yourself in this?**

*One of the clearest signs of abiding in Christ, and part of what it means to fulfill our calling as a human, is a heart being shaped more and more to \_\_\_\_\_ to others.*

**Discussion 3. Do you think your level of generosity is necessarily a fair measure of your spiritual maturity, i.e., of your walk with Christ? If generosity is something God intended for every human, why do you suppose so many people struggle with being generous?**

**Discussion 4. To you, what does it look like for God to provide “spiritual abundance” or “emotional abundance”? Can you think of any other ways Christ followers have an abundant life?**
